People learn differently. That's why we combine an array of "blended learning" tools to deliver the professional development experience best suited to your needs.

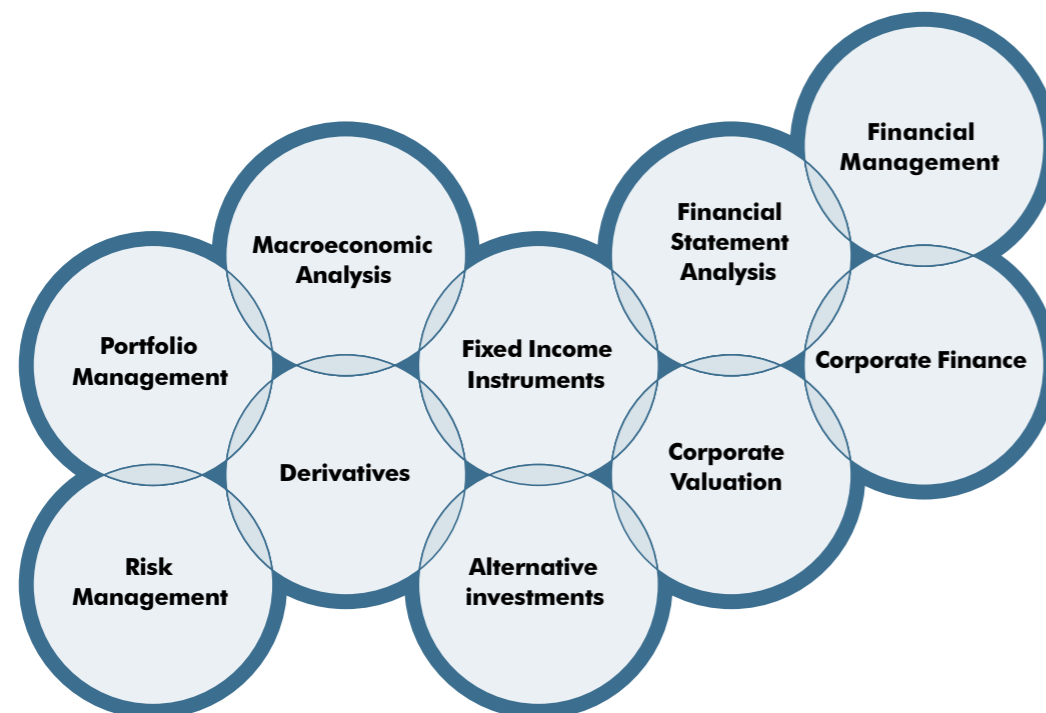

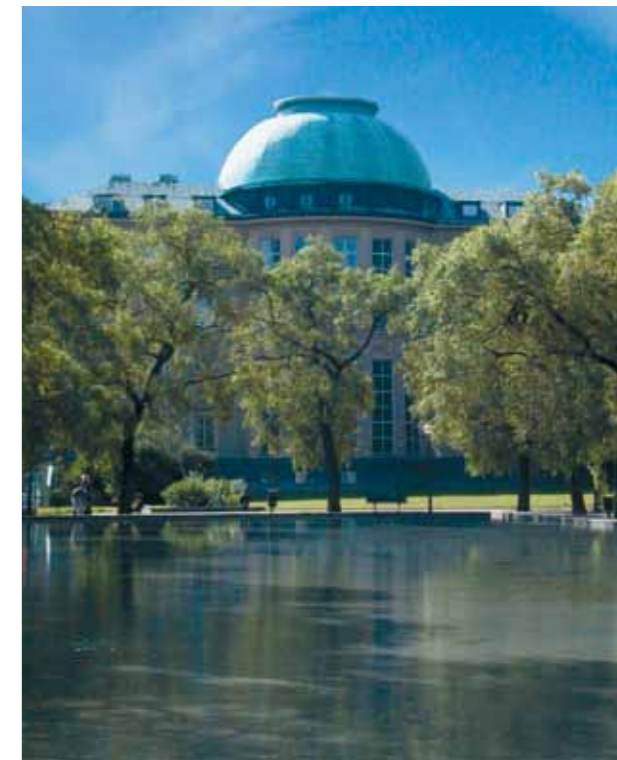
Open Enrollment Programs

Our open enrollment programs are offered regularly and vary in time commitment from one to several weeks. We offer open programs at intermediate and advanced levels. The seven-week Diploma Program for Financial Analysts leads to a CEFA diploma and has been given annually since 1993. Other examples of highly rated programs include Executive Finance Institute's one-week course in investment analysis and a quantitatively oriented course in advanced investment management.

Open enrollment programs vary in length, level and the target groups for which they are intended.

Faculty

Faculty from the Stockholm School of Economics works at the forefront of research in the area of Financial Economics. Currently the SSE Finance Faculty consists of seven full professors and eleven associate and assistant professors from top US and European universities including the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, the University of California Los Angeles, Carnegie Mellon University, London School of Economics and London Business School. The Executive Finance Institute also sources prominent faculty from SIFR - The Institute for Financial Research. SIFR conducts and stimulates high quality research in the field of Finance, and seeks to narrow the gap between academic research and practice in the financial industry.

The Swedish House of Finance

The Swedish House of Finance and SIFR have recently been jointly awarded a substantial grant by the Swedish State to promote Stockholm as a new national center for financial research over a period of ten years, starting in 2011. It will:

- Co-locate Swedish researchers devoted to financial markets and offer a common physical infrastructure
- Create a data center that locates, collects, maintains and administers data that supports research in Finance.
- Offer a national PhD program in Finance
- Support an active visitors program both for domestic and international researchers as well as seminars and conferences
- Facilitate international recruiting of research talent to Swedish universities
- Strengthen Finance education programs in Sweden

Advisory Board

An Advisory Board has been set up to enable the Executive Finance Institute to create innovative programs for participants and companies.



CLAS BERGSTRÖM is Professor of Finance at the Stockholm School of Economics and Head of the Finance Department. Bergström received his doctorate in Economics in 1985 at SSE. Bergström's research and teaching interests lie in the fields of Corporate Finance and Corporate and Securities Law. Bergström is a member of the Scientific Council at the Swedish National Audit Office (SNAO) and the Centre for Business and Policy Studies.

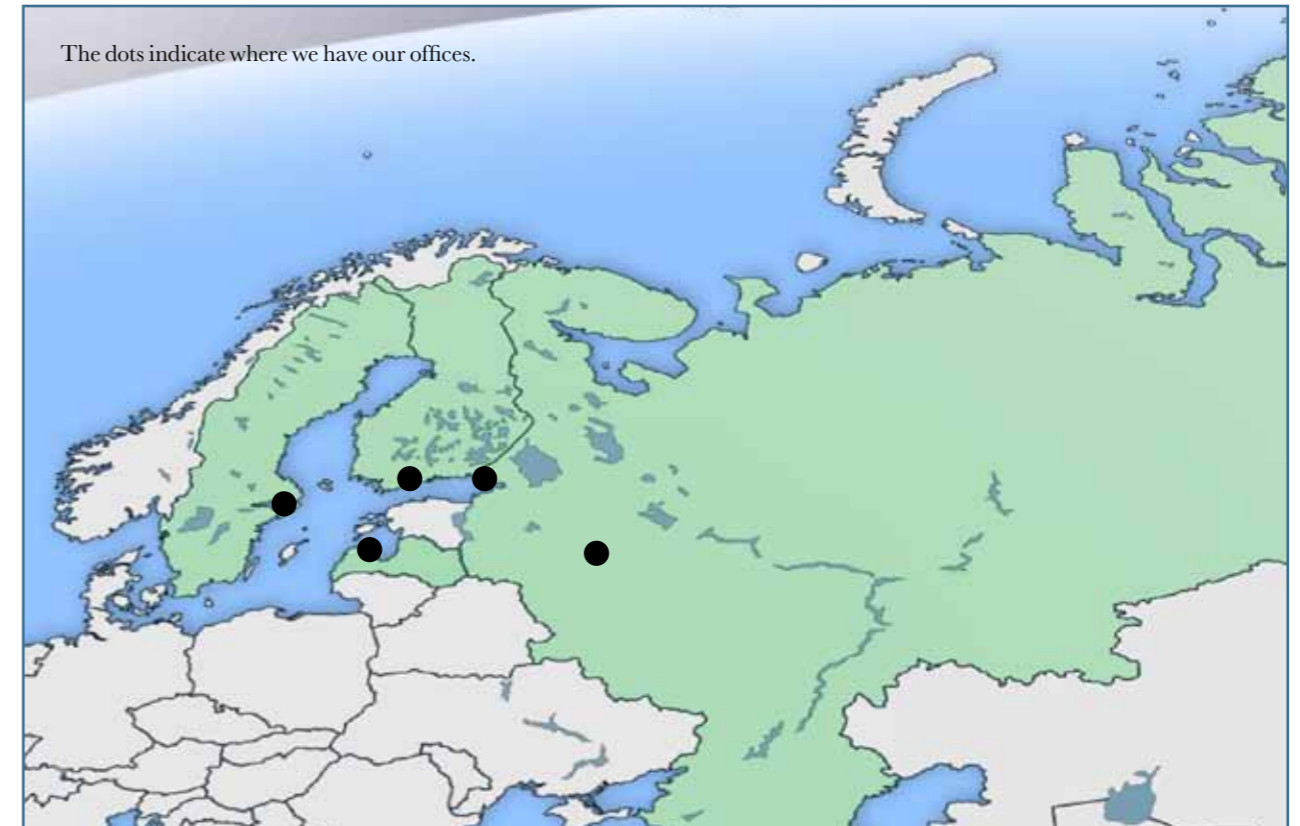


PER STRÖMBERG is Professor of Finance and Private Equity at the Stockholm School of Economics and Head of Research at SIFR. He is also Adjunct Professor at the University of Chicago Booth School of Business, where he has won three best teacher prizes. His research has also been award-winning, two "Brattle Prizes" for best paper in the Journal of Finance. He is a Scientific Advisor to the Swedish Financial Services Authority, and a member of the board of AP6 and Conversus Capital L.P.



MAGNUS DAHLQUIST is Professor of Finance at the Stockholm School of Economics and Research Fellow at the Institute for Financial Research (SIFR). Dahlquist received his doctorate in 1995 at Stockholm University. He served on the faculty of Duke University prior to joining SSE, and has recently visited London Business School. Dahlquist's research and teaching interests lie in the fields of Asset Pricing and International Finance.
